Stonegate North Villages Introduces New Way to Access District Facilities

The district learned a lot as we managed the 2020 pool season during Covid. One of the biggest things learned is how invaluable it is to use technology to our advantage.

Beginning at the end of May, as the pool re-opens for the season, we will transition to a new system that allows residents to use their personal mobile phone as a mobile pass. Your phone will become your key, allowing simple, easy, access.

We are very pleased with the advantages this system will give us — as well as each of you as residents. For the district, this change gives us an opportunity to provide contact-less accessibility, better understand the pool usage patterns and occupancy rates, ensure enhanced safety during off-hours, and do a better job of ensuring only current and authorized residents are using the facilities.

For residents, you no longer have to have a pool card or remember the tennis court code for the Stonegate North Villages Facilities, instead enter with a simple swipe of your smartphone as you enter the pool or

tennis courts.



Eagle Scout's Commitment to Excellence Shows in Stonegate North Village **Project**

As part of his final requirements to achieve the rank of Eagle Scout with Troop 16, young resident Jack Kamm was required to complete a service project to benefit a church, school, or the broader community. With a keen eye for community service, Jack selected to repair and improve a section of fence in the Stonegate North Villages Community Park that borders a culvert pipe drainage area.



According to Jack's project proposal, submitted to the district, "The fence is missing rails and other rails have come loose. I plan to replace the missing rails and improve the sturdiness of the remaining rails by using lag screws instead of nails to attach them to the posts. The fence will then be stained to beautify it and extend the life of the fence. Additionally, the concrete drainage channel will be cleared by shoveling out sediment that is clogging it." We want to acknowledge Jack's service to Stonegate North Villages, commend him for his work, and congratulate him on his rank of Eagle Scout!
