Attendance:

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Directors of Lincoln Park Metropolitan District, Parker, Colorado, was called and conducted in accordance with the applicable statutes of the State of Colorado with the following directors present and acting:

Roll Call and Call to Order:

Director J. Reilly confirmed a quorum was present for the purpose of conducting business and the meeting was called to order. Director J. Reilly requested that Mr. Eames conduct the remainder of the meeting.

Disclosure of Potential Conflict Interest:

Mr. Eames noted that general disclosure statements have been filed as necessary on behalf of the members of the Board of Directors having conflicts of interest with the Office of the Colorado Secretary of State and with the Secretary of the District. Upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, the Board directed that said general disclosures be incorporated herein.

Approval of Agenda:

Public Forum:

Outside Professionals Reports:

Pool Update:

Jaylene Cantrell with Front Range Recreation updated the Board of the final guidelines and/or recommendations from the State regarding the ability for the District to open the pool for the 2020 season. Ms. Cantrell noted that from a company perspective, her firm potentially has the greatest exposure from a liability perspective in opening the pool this season and she feels strongly that to the best of everyone's abilities all State and Local guidelines must be adhered to for her firm to be as protected as reasonably possibly. The Board concurred with Mr. Cantrell's position and went on the discuss the various initial parameters to be able to open the pool for this season.

After a final discussion and review, it was agreed that every effort will be made, to adhere to the requirements as set out in the new guidelines as provided by Front Range Recreation, to open the pool for the 2002 season starting Monday, June 8th.

Communications and Branding:

Director J. Reilly opened the floor for comments/suggestions from the Board on the proposed new logo design concepts as created and provided by Jennifer Dulles and Kym Foster with DStreet.
