### New Upper Deck

Please also remember not to move the cabana furniture as it can damage the furniture and the deck. ### Reminder, No Glass, Even in the Trash

As a reminder, there is to be no glass brought into the pool area. This includes bringing in glass containers, but also disposing of glass containers in any of the trash cans surrounding the pool area and pool deck. Glass disposed of in these containers can be accidentally broken as the trash is being emptied. If glass shatters and breaks the entire pool could need to be closed for clean-up, and the pool drained to ensure no shards or remnants are in the pool itself. Please help us avoid this type of situation by keeping any and all glass containers at home and keeping even the trash cans free of any discarded glass.
